The Television Jamaica Schools' Challenge Quiz Scholarship

Television Jamaica is pleased to invite applications for the 2024 TVJ JSCQ Scholarship.

The student who is awarded this scholarship will get assistance that is valued at Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) each year for three years to assist in funding their tertiary education. The total value of TVJ Schools' Challenge Quiz scholarship at the end of three (3) years is One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00).

The funds in the scholarship are earmarked to assist in offsetting fees and books where possible. The money **will not** be disbursed directly to the student. The student to be awarded the scholarship will be selected by TVJ.

Eligibility for scholarship

Who can apply

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship the student must have been a sitting player in the 2024 season of TVJ's Schools' Challenge Quiz.

Matriculation in Jamaica

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship the student should have an acceptance offer from a tertiary institution in Jamaica to commence classes in September 2024. If you have received a provisional acceptance, kindly indicate said on the application form. Full acceptance letter should be supplied as soon as possible..

To be considered for this scholarship, student should submit an essay not exceeding 700 words on the topic “ ***Why I will be an asset to Jamaica after tertiary studies***”

Maintain Grades

The scholarship recipient will be required to maintain a minimum GPA average of 3.0. Failure to maintain this average could result in the loss of the scholarship.

Scholarship may be terminated if student changes course of study without prior approval from TVJ

TVJ Experience

The scholarship recipient will be offered a two-weeks summer experience at TVJ on conditions that they are no disruptive conditions.
